

## THIRD SCOUTERS' EXTRA CHALLENGE

August 25-28, 2015

Clarín School of Fisheries, Clarín, Bohol

### GUIDELINES

1. The Challenge is open to all registered Adults. However, districts must register their participants by team since activities/contests will be conducted by team of eight (8) members preferably 4 male and 4 female composed of the following: Langkay Leader, Kawan Leader, Troop Leader, Outfit Advisor, Circle Manager and Leader of Adult who are graduates of the Basic Training Course. To complete the 8-member team, atleast one Unit/District Committee member or District PTA Official MUST be recruited as team member who may not be graduates of the BTC. Districts may organize a maximum of three (3) teams only.
  2. Major activities in the challenge will be Clarín Challenge, Water Challenge, Skills Challenge, Song Scouters Sing and Community Emersion/Service. All teams are required to render a demonstration of Livelihood Project/s (food processing or manufacture of any product etc) specialized in their municipality to the local residents of Clarín. Name of project must be submitted on or before August 12, 2017.
  3. All participating teams are advised to study and review the following references for the skills and scout ideals: Handbook for Boys, Advancement and Merit Badge Manual, Knots and Lashing Manual and the Advancement Handbook for Kab Scouts (Young USA, Growing USA and Leaping USA, Handbook for Senior Scout which is the 13 and above, vol. 1 and 2, etc)
  4. Transportation to and from the venue of all activities will be the responsibility of each team.
  5. Preparation of souvenir items will be based on the confirmed participants and will be on a first come first served basis.
  6. Contingent Heads meeting will be on August 25, 2017 at 10:00 in the morning. Contingent head and/or a representative must attend.
  7. All participating teams are responsible for the safety of their valuable items such as; cellular phones, jewelries, etc.
  8. Each team should have a team flag with the size of 12" x 16" indicating their team's name. {Name of district with the team name such as animals, fish, birds, heroes, historical places, or their respective tourist attraction, etc.}
  9. All teams must have enough tents for all members.
  10. Food provision for the whole duration of the activity will be responsibility of the each team.
  11. Each district must also prepare/compose a scout song for the Song Scouters Sing.
    - It can be a solo, duet or trio but the rest of the team should be present at the stage as back-up singers.
    - Time limit is 3-5 minutes including the 30-seconds or less entrance and exit in a form of a yell.
    - Wear Type A uniform
    - Any scout song and it can be a medley
    - Use of accompanying equipment is open.
    - Criteria for judging shall be:
      - a. Mastery of piece - 25%
      - b. Instrumentation - 25%
      - c. Originality - 25%
      - d. Showmanship - 25%
- Note: Only 1 team from each district is allowed to present.
12. There will be a Campcraft Showcase. Thus, all teams are encouraged to have a display of projects specifically labeled from KID, KAB, Boy and Senior Scouts section.

### WHAT TO BRING TO THE CHALLENGE

#### TEAM:

- ✓ Team Flag
- ✓ Kitchen Utensils
- ✓ Enough tents for the members
- ✓ Compass
- ✓ First Aid Kit
- ✓ Materials for the demonstration of Livelihood project
- ✓ 9 pcs of abaca rope smaller than pencil size  
1 ½ meters long

#### INDIVIDUAL:

- ✓ Type A and B uniforms
- ✓ Personal Tent
- ✓ Five meters long pencil-size abaca string
- ✓ Knife, Raincoat and Flashlight
- ✓ Sleeping kit with waterproof mat preferably
- ✓ Swimming gear
- ✓ Notebook/ Ballpen
- ✓ Rubber shoes
- ✓ At least 5 meter long pencil-size rope preferably abaca.
