

## MECHANICS OF THE SINGING BEE CONTEST

- This contest will test the players' knowledge on songs and song lyrics of different genres.
- The same mechanics will apply to all contest categories.
  - Individual
    - Student contestant
    - Teacher contestant
  - Group
    - Compose of 3 students
    - Compose of 3 teachers
- The competition will follow three rounds and of different levels of difficulty.
- The first round is called TO BE CONTINUED. The host would provide the year the song was released, the performer, and the title of the song. A portion of the song is performed, and then the contestant/s has to attempt to sing the next line of the song. A buzzer will be provided to determine who will have the first attempt. If correct, they will advance to the next round, and a new song is introduced, which the other contestants must attempt. A song is thrown out if none of the remaining contestants get the line correct. The first **four** (may vary) contestants who performed the song correctly will qualify to the next round.
- The second round is called TO BE CORRECTED. The host would provide the year the song was released, the performer, and the title of the song. A portion of the song is performed and wrong line is sung at the end, and then the contestant/s has to attempt to correct the wrong line of the song. The first to press the buzzer will have the first attempt. If correct, they advance to the next round, and a new song is introduced, which the other contestant/s must attempt. A song is thrown out if none of the remaining contestants get the line correct. The first two players/group who get a song line correct move on to the final round.
- The final round is called BEEDEOKE. The qualifiers try to sing a song in a fill-in-the-blank format and correctly answer twelve blanks (three blanks for each contestant). Each correct word is worth three points. The contestant who accumulated the most points will be awarded as champion. In the event of a tie a new song will be played.
