

Good Day!

As we continue to move forward in our partnership in the implementation of the School-based DRR Project in the municipalities of Maribojoc and Loon, we would like to update you that we already completed the one-year program implementation. Within a year, we have already implemented activities, such as capacity building interventions for teachers (2 batches of ToT on DRR), student leaders (DRR Trainings for 110 school children, Student Leaders and Facilitators Training, Children's Summer Camp 2015), local government officials and other stakeholders about Disaster Risk Reduction. Likewise, we also conducted the hazard, vulnerability and capacity assessment (HVCA) for communities, continuous provision of technical support and complementation in establishing local DRRM structures at the LGUs (municipal and barangays) and for the schools DRRM groups; and other program-related support.

For Year 2 of the program implementation, we would like to complement DepEd in promoting the Comprehensive Safety School Framework as well as ensure that children, teachers, and other people in the communities are safe from any hazard that can occur in their area. We still need to continue strengthening their capacities, awareness level on DRR/CCA and increase their knowledge by conducting other activities, such as determining the possible hazards to occur in schools and to assess the weaknesses or vulnerabilities and capacities of teachers, students and even the existing structures and mechanisms in the school. Other activities where Save the Children will implement for this coming months in partnership with DepEd are as follows:

  - June 24, 2015 – Loon North District
  - July 1, 2015 – Loon South District
  - July 9, 2015 – Maribojoc District
