

**SUBJECT : CORNERSTONE PROGRAM IMPLEMENTERS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2015-2016**

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1. In partnership with **Ateneo Center for Educational Development (ACED)** – the arm of the Ateneo de Manila University, **Couples for Christ-Bohol Global Mission Foundation, Inc. (CFC)** and **DepED-Bohol**, in helping public basic education in the country introduced “**Cornerstone Program**” that seek to equip children, youth and adults in the school community with the human and social, moral, spiritual, and professional aspects of development. Moreover, skills will be provided in order to improve student performance and enable participants to become productive members of society.

The **Cornerstone Program** has four components, to wit: 1) The Elementary Program aims to reach out to slow readers in public schools through reading tutorials and orient their values through formation sessions. 2) The High School Program aims to reach out to High School students through leadership and values formation. 3) Family support is provided through Parenting Formation and, 4) Child Sponsorships will be given to gifted students in the public schools.
3. As a matter of support, this Office hereby endorsed the program to the schools indicated above. Service Credits shall be given to teachers who will be assigned as Cornerstone School Coordinator/Teacher Adviser and volunteers in the program. An **Orientation** to be attended by the School Head/Principal and School Coordinator (preferably Couples for Christ/Singles for Christ Member) of the above schools will be conducted on Thursday, July 30, 2015 from 1:00-4:00pm at DepED-Bohol Conference Room, New Capitol Site, Tagbilaran City.
4. Travelling expenses incurred in attending this Orientation shall be charged to School MOOE and other Funds subject to the usual accounting & auditing rules of the COA.
