

SUBJECT : **PRES. MANUEL L. QUEZON AND SCOUTING MONTH**

1. It was during the presidency of late Manuel L. Quezon that Commonwealth Act 111 was signed into law creating the Boy Scouts of the Philippines and it was on October 31, 1936.
2. Late President Manuel L. Quezon was born on August 19, 1878. Thus, the council is inviting all institutions and scouting units to join in the celebration of his birth anniversary by conducting a commemorative activity such as; school level camping, scout rally, hiking & cook out, community service/development activities, etc... to instill in the hearts and minds of the scouts the contribution of the late president to the movement.
3. The month of October is declared as the Scouting Month of each year. To this effect, we are encouraging all districts to conduct the District Camporal and Round Up during the month to give our scouts the opportunity to exhibit the skills they have learned during their patrol and sub-group meetings.
4. Scouts from all sections are encouraged to participate in this camp. However, Kid and Kab scouts should not stay overnight at the camp unless appropriate sleeping quarters for them are provided.
5. Service credits/Compensatory <sup>Time</sup> Day Off will be granted to teachers and administrators participating in this camp provided advancement reports are submitted after the conduct of the camp. Advancement Report forms are available at the council or maybe downloaded from Bohol Council, BSP group on Facebook.
6. As usual, districts are encouraged to organize a Round Up Team to monitor the schools' implementation while the Council Round Up Team will visit the conducting districts at random. Thus, schools/districts are advised to submit their respective program of activities to the council. Please find suggested activities in the attached sample Program of Activities.
7. Submission of reports either in hard or soft copy with documentation at the council will be very much appreciated.
8. All concerned must make sure that participating scouts are currently registered members of the BSP and shall wear the prescribed scout uniform.
9. Please be guided accordingly.
