
COUNCIL MEMORANDUM

TO : All Area/District Chairmen, District Commissioners, Deputy District Commissioners, Heads of Institutions, District Field Commissioners, Unit Leaders, PTA Officials/Members, Members of the Municipal Scouting Committee and all concerned.

SUBJECT : 3rd SCOUTERS' EXTRA CHALLENGE

1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the 3rd Adults' Extra Challenge on August 25-28, 2017 at Clarin National School of Fisheries, Clarin, Bohol.
2. The challenge aims to expose the adult leaders to the different exciting, adventurous and skills learning activities in scouting for them also to implement to the scouts in their respective units.
3. The challenge is open to all duly registered scouters (unit leaders, unit committee members, commissioners and municipal scouting officials including officers and members of the PTA) and physically fit as certified by a physician.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) per participant will be collected to cover the cost of souvenir items, challenge materials/equipment and other administrative expenses. Registration and other related expenses is chargeable to the MOOE and other Local Funds.
5. Each district is encouraged to send at least one (1) team (8 scouters) preferably composed of unit leader from the KID, KAB, Boy and Senior Scout sections who are graduates of the Basic Training course and are currently handling a scout unit with a Leader of Adult/Unit Committee member preferably BTC graduate also. All activities in the challenge will be performed by teams. Districts may send a maximum of 3 teams only to participate. All participating adults will be entitled to service credits in accordance with the prevailing policy while administrators who are not entitled to service credits will earn compensatory time off credits.
6. Major activities of the challenge will be the Skills Challenge, Water Challenge, Clarinb Challenge, Community Emersion & Skills Showcase incorporated with the different scouting skills other activities included are campfire, song scouters sing, tree planting, etc.
7. The community emersion is an activity where each participating team will be required to exhibit their own livelihood/product which is not common to other municipalities. The exhibit should also include the procedure in production (printed procedure should be provided). Transportation is the responsibility of each team during the emersion.
8. Official list of participants with t-shirt size must be submitted on or before August 5, 2017 for souvenir preparation purposes.
