Greetings from IDEA Philippines!

As your partner in educating the deaf in the province of Bohol, we are constantly looking for ways on how to support the teachers of the Deaf in terms of skills enhancement as well as additional knowledge on their particular field of teaching.

In line with the abovementioned goal, we are once again holding a 3-day seminar workshop for the teachers of the Deaf on October 25-27, 2017 to be held at Dao Diamond Hotel, Dao District, Tagbilaran City.
