The Provincial Government of Bohol is gearing once again to commemorate the fourth anniversary of the tragic M7.2 earthquake that struck the province of Bohol on October 15, 2013 which brought massive devastation, both to our infrastructure and our people.

Despite the destruction the earthquake brought us, which was aggravated by the effect of Typhoon Yolanda weeks after, Boholanos remained strong and steadfast and relied on each other to rise from the rubbles.

With this year's theme "*The Resilient Bohol: Overcoming Challenges Partnerships Shared Leadership*", the Day will start with a **Holy Mass at 7:30 in the morning** at the St. Joseph's Cathedral.
