It has been successful with its various cultural missions aboard, that includes 31 international tours, and performed in 37 countries, in Europe, Middle East, South America, United States of America and South East Asia and still continue up to this day, our most recent was in 2018 3rd cultural mission to Southern part of the United States of America for 2 months. 2019 World Flora Exposition in Taichung, Taiwan. In 2020 even at the height of pandemic we continued our mission to present the lighter side of the world during its trying times, we participated on the 24th international folklore festival in Sophia, Bulgaria, and in 2021. Leyte Kalipayan first voyage was in 1964 when it was designated by President Diosdado Macapagal as the official cultural ambassador to foreign land.

Being in ground zero after typhoon Yolanda was never a hindrance to keep our advocacy, Six (6) months after typhoon Yolanda we were called by Cultural Center of the Philippines to represent Philippines for the cultural exchange during the 82nd birthday of Queen Sirikit of Thailand, then followed with ASEAN Summit in Nay Pyi Taw in, Myanmar in 2014. In 2016, it was recognized by world dance organization, and now Leyte Kalipayan Dance Company included on the list as one of the best in the world (www.dance.dance.com).

# Company Profile

The Leyte kalipayan Dance Company, one of the best folkloric dance troupes in the Philippines today, has been dancing for 61 years across the globe. It's a home grown folk dance troupe, an accredited non-profit organization of the province of Leyte.

The Company started out as the Leyte Filipiniana Dance troupe, founded in 1961 by Teresita Veloso Pil, with the encouragement of Sister Mary Canisius Murphy, the School Directress then of the Holy Infant College in Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines

The dance troupe is composed of young high school and college students from different Colleges and Universities in the region. These students were considered scholars of the dance troupe who are not only trained to become exemplary in the field of arts, but training includes value and character formation of the dancers for them to become good cultural ambassadors and better citizens of our society.

It has undergone 31 international tours, and performed in 37 countries, in the Middle East, South America, United States of America, Europe, and Southeast Asia. Achievements includes a major awards, winning silver medal in an International Folklore Festival in Dijon, France, a grantee of the Cultural Center of the Philippines, and an awardee of the National Gawad for Dance. It was internationally recognized and now listed as one of the Best Dance Companies in the World by World Folklore Organization in 2016 (www.danceanddance.com).

The initial public performance was in September 1961 for the school's college day celebration. From that point forward, it was an onward push for the young dance troupe when invitations began to pour in, propelling its performance tours in the municipal, regional, national and international levels.

It was on 1965, on its 4th anniversary, when then Philippine President Diosdado Macapagal designated the dance group as the official cultural ambassador for abroad and left for 10 months to the United States, danced and electrified a whole nation with their endearing exuberance.



In 1980, the dance troupe participated at various international folklore festivals in Israel, Italy and Switzerland and won the silver medal at the Dijon International Folkloric Festival in France, where 32 other international groups contended. In 1981 the company visited Saudi Arabia where it won the hearts and admiration of 12,000 Filipinos. 1982 was a banner year with performances at the 1982 World-Fair in Knoxville, Tennessee. They as well attended the prestigious Wolf Trap International Children Festival in Virginia, U.S.A., travelled to New York City and Washington D.C. to perform on the occasion of the state visit of President Ferdinand Marcos in September 1982.

In 1990, they were designated as the official Philippine delegate to the 1990 Asian Folklore Festival held in Malaysia, wherein the Leyte Kalipayan Dance Company was the only Filipino dance troupe member of International Council of Organizations for Folklore Festivals and Folk Art (CIOFF) based in Europe.

Manifesting exemplary performance during the festival, was a gateway towards more European tours. They danced their way into the hearts of the audience at the various folklore festivals in Spain and Portugal in 1993; The Netherlands, Belgium and England 1995; Germany and Portugal in 2009; and due to popular request, they made a Third time tour to Spain, Italy and Switzerland. Beijing China in 2006 Folklore Festival.

In November 8, **2013**, this legendary institution survived the devastation of super-typhoon Hayan aka ("Yolanda"), the strongest typhoon in the history of mankind that made land fall, which caused the dance troupe to lose everything that mattered to them, a rehearsal hall called home for 40 years, and treasures preserved for 5 decades. Indeed, the devastation brought the dance troupe to ground zero.

To this effect, because of social responsibilities it has to forcibly get up on its feet, facing uncertainties where the road would lead them after math.

Despite the status quo and being homeless for years, the shattering made them not lose hope, but rather relied on the wonderful gift of talent from GOD, that gave courage to face life challenges, which led themselves to find means to bring back the dance troupe to its normal form. They used costumes that were hand-picked from the ruins, and very grateful to some alumni who spared to buy costumes and instruments. Unfortunately another typhoon "Urduha" struck the province, were all



Instruments were soaked in water, for venue was not available to safe keep all costumes, props and instruments.

The dance troupe is having its temporary shelter and their 11th venue at Holy Virgin of Salvacion, through the family of Dr.Conchita Merin, who were kind enough to accommodate the group, while still finding its way towards our new permanent dwelling place.

The Leyte Kalipayan Dance Troupe Inc. endured to live, kept its mission, and its social responsibilities to its countrymen. After surviving from the disaster, "Kalipayan Voices' was formed to present on behalf of the Dance troupe who was still on ground zero ,with selected kalipayan members with high caliber singing voice were taken in for the singing aroup, which made the Leyte Kalipayan Company Continue its mission with Kalipayan Voices as front while the dance troupe was recovering. On January 20, 2014 "Kalipayan Voices" sang for the king of Sweden, on February 20, 2014, Voices with Rondalla performed for World Tourism Governor, hosted by the Governor of Leyte, Dominico Leopoldo Petilla. May 31, 2014, the Leyte Kalipayan Dance Company had its first ever performance after Yolanda, a thanks giving show initiated by the dance troupe which was dedicate to the different INGO's who helped rebuild Leyte fast, held at Palo Municipal Hall, Palo, Leyte sponsored by Mayor Remedios Petilla, and the Department of Tourism Eastern Visayas Regions, through Director Karen Tiopes. On June 15 Leyte kalipayan being back on their feet performs for the German guests of Cathy Buenvitacola, held at Pasqualino, St Rita Samar. On June 27 the Municipality of Palo through Mayor Remedios Petilla who hosted another thanks giving show for Korean Military Volunteers, succeeded by another thanks giving show hosted by City of Tacloban through Honorable Mayor Alfred Romualdez for Pacific & American friendship, volunteer soldiers who helped on the rehabilitation of the province of Leyte, and the city of Tacloban.

As it continued to prosper, in 2014 right after the devastation it responded to the Philippines National Government call through National Commission for culture and Arts and Department of Foreign Affairs to represent Philippines on the 82<sup>nd</sup> birthday of Queen Sirikit of Thailand. On October 8, 2014 the dance troupe performs for Freight Process Out Sourcing Solution inauguration, October 20, 2014 70th Leyte Landing Anniversary, performed for Philippine President Benigno" Noynoy' Aquino and dignitaries.



**December 2014** Leyte Kalipayan was designated as official cultural ambassador for cultural exchange at 2014 ASEAN SUMMIT held at Nay Pi Taw, Myanmar.

2015 was also a busy year for the dance troupe with significant performances was in store in their own locality, to start with Jan 3 an exclusive show for Veloso-Wright Nuptial at Hotel Alejandro, Tacloban, January 04 Thanks giving show for donors who help rebuild Sto Nino Church that was wrecked by typhoon Yolanda. January 17, 2015 an audience with Pope Francis during his Pastoral visit at Daniel Z. Romualdez Airport. March 21 exclusive performance for Ms. Julie Anover German guests, at Pasqualino, Sta Rita, Samar. May 9, 2015 performance for TY Family Hermanidad in Pinabacdao, Samar. May 23- LIDE, Isabel, Leyte, May 30 Leyte kalipayan Dance Company Summer Recital, at Leyte Normal gym. July 17 Exclusive for Pil- Veloso Clan Reunion at Patio Victoria,. November 9 & 12, 2019 Leyte Kalipayan Dance Company Rondalla performed with Philippines National Artist for Music Dr. Ramon Santos and UP An Balangaw in commemoration for the 7<sup>th</sup> anniversary of typhoon Yolanda through a Sarswela entitled "Lunop Han Dughan", at Leyte Normal University gym, Tacloban City. **In 2020 representation in World Folklore Festival in Sophia, Burlagi**a, **2021 Nova Prata Brasil.
