RESPONSE INTERVENTION DUE TO EXTREME HEAT

TO: PUBLIC SCHOOLS DISTRICT SUPERVISORS/ OIC-PSDSs ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL HEADS DISTRICT DRRM COORDINATORS ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

- 1. As the dry and warm season begins, the Department of Education has implemented various precautionary measures to safeguard the health, safety, and well-being of its learners and personnel while continuously delivering its mandate on quality education.
- 2. In response to the call of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) to all NDRRM Member Agencies, based on NDRRMC Memorandum No. 031, s. 2024, to undertake resource inventory and stockpiling/prepositioning of response supplies, equipment, and other resources, the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) provides additional response interventions to cover the effects of the extreme heat being experienced in all public schools.
