## CONDUCT OF BOHOL YOUTH CONVERGENCE 2024: "EMBRACING GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP"

- 1. In relation to DepEd Memorandum No. 029, s. 2024 titled Learners' Convergence Philippines 2024, and in line with the Department of Educations' MATATAG Agenda, particularly its commitment to take good care of learners through promoting learner well-being, inclusive education, and a positive learning environment. The Division of Bohol, Youth Formation Section in partnership with the Provincial Government of Bohol will conduct the Bohol Youth Convergence 2024, under the theme "Embracing Global Citizenship", on July 5, 2024, at Bohol Cultural Center, CPG North Avenue, Tagbilaran City.
- 2. The Bohol Youth Convergence aims to:
  - a. Promote leadership and life skills among youth participants.
  - b. Enhance awareness and engagement in global citizenship and community issues.
  - c. Provide platform for the youth to voice their ideas and solutions towards achieving educational and societal goals; and
  - d. foster collaboration among students through sharing of best practices.
- 3. Participation in the Bohol Youth Convergence 2024 shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time pursuant to the provisions set in DO 003, s. 2024 and DO 022, s. 2023. The target participants are the newly elected District Federated President only of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG), and the newly elected Supreme Secondary Learner Government President of every secondary school in the Division of Bohol. The Teacher-Adviser of the SELG/SSLG will serve as guardian throughout the duration and at the same time participant to the convergence. Parents' Consent is a must to all student leader participants and the Teacher-Adviser shall keep custody of it. Please see enclosure no.1 for the required Parents' Consent template.
- 4. No registration fee shall be collected from the school participants with only one (1) student leader and his/ her respective adviser. If the secondary school is willing to send a maximum of two (2) student leaders, the additional one will pay the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) registration chargeable against school MOOE, SSLG fund, and other available funds for the one full board duration of the event payable at the cashier section of the division office and present a copy of the official receipt at the venue or earlier.
